Vestry Key Messages

January 9, 2025

- Immanuel’s Annual General Meeting will be held on Sunday, February 9th after the 10:00 am service. A light lunch and childcare will be available.
- Vestry approved a request to install two railings at the front of the sanctuary and a request to purchase a small number of the new Anglican Hymn book ‘Sing a New Creation’ for use by the choir, musicians, and clergy leadership.
- Four proposals were approved for using the interest on the Immanuel Trust. They include funds for digital ministry, a part-time temporary contract for a children and youth worker, and the first phase of some enhancements to the front lawn.
- The Diocese approved the funding from the Immanuel Trust for the upgrade to the windows in the hall, and the funds have been received. The work will be scheduled soon.
- There was a small deficit for the month of November. The Christmas Market and Snowflake Tea added several thousand dollars of fundraising money to our revenues.
- Mission Driven Stewardship will kick off on Sunday, January 26th.
- Seven young people will be confirmed on March 2, 2025.
- Immanuel will host the Diocesan Synod which will take place May 22 – 25 2025. It will begin on Thursday evening, May 22nd, rather than on Friday May 23rd as originally planned.
